## WORKED BONE p 3

- 96 L r 50 edges of rib with diagonal cuts where they have been carved off the main rib.
- " L r c.130 <sup>obviously</sup> not worked but clearly bone working debris. splinters, broken pieces. With few exceptions, pieces of cattle size rib.  
 I think they are cattle not horse, which have a less smooth flat surface, and are narrower - give less
- " " 107 same (of a wide flat surface.)
- 96 ✓ Antler see deer.
- " (✓ cattle tibia 1mm, probably sawn chopped)
- 96 Ribs, large. <sup>129</sup> With articulation. Atm Virtually certain horse. All chopped thru from medial side 7-17 cm from prox end.
