

IRON AGE HUMAN BONE

- Iron Age contexts 0506 Skull fragment: adult or sub adult
- 0609 Tibia: foetal or newborn
- 1538 Partial foetal skeleton: most of skull
 including right mandible
 two vertebral fragments
 both scapulae
 both humeri (max. L. = 67mm)
 both ulnae and radii
 left tibia (max. L. = 68mm)
 one metacarpal
- Age estimated as 7 - 8 months, based
on lengths of humeri and tibia using
chart of R. Powers (unpublished,
British Museum (Natural History)).
- 'Roman' contexts 0443 Mandible, with alveolus for posterior
 permanent molar.
- 0444 Tibia: foetal or newborn.
- 'Probable Roman' context 0432 Skull fragment: adult or sub adult
